from the Brazen Altar up through the Table of Shewbread.

<b>SP1 A</b>	<p><b>STATURE – 1<sup>st</sup> Message</b> Introducing the Old Testament Tabernacle and God’s pattern for spiritual growth. Three reasons for studying the Old Testament Tabernacle. Statures of comparison between the Old Testament Tabernacle and Jesus Christ, the second Tabernacle. Drawing out of the seal of the Bride, as found in Exodus 40. The Blood side of the seal of the Bride: (A) Sin offering, and (B) Whole burnt offering (consecration). Four ways to apply the Blood of Jesus Christ.</p>	<b>Sun. am 6-16-63</b>
<b>SP1 B</b>	<p><b>STATURE – 2<sup>nd</sup> Message</b> Seal of the Blood continued with (C) Blood of the peace offering which brings union with Jesus Christ. Ingredients of the holy anointing oil, consisting of myrrh (humility), sweet cinnamon (goodness), sweet calamus (gentleness), cassia (surrender), and oil olive. The blood of the peace offering applied to the right ear, right thumb and right great toe.</p>	<b>Mon. am 6-17-63</b>
<b>SP2</b>	<p><b>STATURE – 3<sup>rd</sup> Message</b> Seal of the Spirit, introducing (I) Power, (II) Gifts, and (III) Fire. Lesson on: I. Power (demonstration) side of the Spirit, covering fourteen aspects of the demonstrations of the Holy Ghost.</p>	<b>Tue. am 6-18-63</b>
<b>SP3</b>	<p><b>STATURE – 4<sup>th</sup> Message</b> II. Gift side of the Holy Ghost. Lesson on the Tower of the Will of God as found in I Corinthians 12; explanation of the Word gifts being head of the Spirit gifts, with Love as the head of both. Two classes of prophets: Word and Spirit and their respective ministries; includes the destructive and constructive sides of the ministry of a Word prophet.</p>	<b>Wed. am 6-19-63</b>
<b>SP4 A</b>	<p><b>STATURE – 5<sup>th</sup> Message</b> God’s order of the Word gifts in the Church (A) Evangelists, (B) Pastors and Teachers, (C) Prophets, and (D) Apostles. Four reasons why God withdraws spiritual gifts. The reason that sometimes a message in tongues is short but the interpretation long. The eleven gifts of the Spirit as found in I Corinthians 12:8-10 and verse 28. The basic stature of the Witness of the Holy Ghost (Urim and Thummin in O.T.) with (A) God’s provision to know His Will, (B) God’s warning, (C) God’s command, and (D) God’s judgment. 	greatest judgment one can receive is silence from the Lord. A stature on the ministry of the Holy Ghost in the Book of Acts: (A) Speaks, (B) Sends forth, (C) Governs, and (D) Witnesses. Also the ministry of the Holy Ghost in John 16:7-15: (A) Comforter, (B) Reprover, (C) Guide, and (D) Shews us the things of Jesus.	
<b>SP4 B</b>	<p><b>STATURE – 6<sup>th</sup> Message</b></p> <p>III. Fire side of the Holy Ghost, completing the seal of the Spirit in the Courtyard. A stature on the power of the fire in regard to (A) Our will, (B) Murmuring, (C) Spiritual pride, and (D) Rebellion. Three places God promised to meet with the Nation of Israel (and us): (A) Whole burnt offering at the Brazen Altar, (B) Altar of Incense, and (C) Art of the Covenant; how the espousal is continued throughout the stature until marriage takes place.</p>	<b>Fri. am 6-21-63</b>
<b>SP5</b>	<p><b>STATURE – 7<sup>th</sup> Message</b></p> <p>Study on the Laver with (I) the Name, (II) Death, and (III) Life. This lesson covers (I) the Name of Jesus Christ in the waters of baptism. Stature of obedience to baptize in Jesus' Name in the Book of Acts. A stature on (A) Origin of His Name, (B) Purpose of Name, (C) Persecution for the Name, and (D) Position of the Name. Four ways by which revelation comes: (A) Plain study, (B) Prayer, (C) Fasting, and (D) By gift of wisdom.</p>	<b>Sun. am 6-23-63</b>
<b>SP6</b>	<p><b>STATURE – 8<sup>th</sup> Message</b></p> <p>Questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. I John 3:8,9; explanation of “Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin.”</li> <li>2. Will the Devil tempt you after God puts “the will and do” in you?</li> <li>3. Questions concerning hair: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. When should a sister start growing long hair?</li> <li>b. Is a man to grow a beard?</li> <li>c. What is meant by broidered hair?</li> <li>d. Why does one curl the hair?</li> <li>e. What works the “do” in us?</li> <li>f. Are sisters to wear their hair down or up?</li> <li>g. How does a man suffer when his wife has long hair?</li> <li>h. Should children come under parents regarding hair?</li> <li>i. What about going to work with stringy hair?</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <p>Four stages we go through when we are faced with God's Headship in our lives: (A) Why?, (B) How long?, (C) Surrender, and (D) Delight. Stature of the carnal flesh with its (A) Lust, (B) Warfare, (C) Works, and (D) Fruit. Stature on a carnal woman: (A) Plots against the man, (B) Deceives by adornment, (C) Instills poison, and (D) Takes captive.</p>	<b>Mon. am 6-24-63</b>

	<p>4. Concerning the Oneness of the Godhead, with its three streams of revelation as Father, Word, and Holy Ghost. How the Prophets, Jews and Jesus, Apostles and even devils all declare the oneness of God.</p> <p>5. Review of the threefold nature chart.</p> <p>6. The three times Jesus reigns on the earth (A) On throne of humility while in flesh, (B) On throne of David during 1,000 year reign, and (C) From New City or the Universal reign. The various degrees of glory as revealed in I Corinthians 15:40-42; also meaning of being baptized for the dead.</p>	
<b>SP7</b>	<p><b>STATURE – 9<sup>th</sup> Message</b></p> <p>Continuation of study on the Laver: (II) Death side of the Water. How His death, resurrection, the Word and the Spirit will lead one to full stature in Romans 6. Four ways by which we partake of His death: (A) By baptism, (B) Burial, (C) Planting, and (D) Crucifixion. How His resurrection life gives (A) Newness of life, (B) Likeness of His Glory, (C) Life with Him, and (D) Victory over death. The Word in its (A) Reckoning power, (B) Reigning power, (C) Giving power to not yield to sin, and (D), Giving power to help us yield to God. The seven times the word <i>Word</i> is capitalized in the Bible. The stature on the ministry of the Spirit; also the statures on reckoning, and the resurrections. The four paradises mentioned in the Word: (A) Garden of Eden, (B) Abraham’s bosom, (C) Heavenly paradise, and (D) New City Paradise.</p>	<b>Tues. am 6-25-63</b>
<b>SP8</b>	<p><b>STATURE – 10<sup>th</sup> Message</b></p> <p>Question on Matthew 24:28 “Wheresoever the carcass is there will the eagles be gathered together.” Stature on judgment in Revelation 19:11-20 at the Battle of Armageddon. Four signs in the heavens: (A) Darkness of sun, moon, and stars, (B) Blood, (C) Sign of heat, and (D) Angel. Study on the Altar of Incense with its three sides to prayer: (A) Asking, (B) Intercession, and (C) Travail. Five ingredients of the incense used at the Golden Altar of Prayer. This lesson includes (A) Stature on Asking, (B) Stature on Intercession, with Jesus as our example in interceding for transgressors, for those persecuted, for perfection and interceding against death, (C) Travailing prayer with its thirteen degrees.</p>	<b>Wed. am 6-26-63</b>
<b>SP9</b>	<p><b>STATURE – 11<sup>th</sup> Message</b></p> <p>Question from Luke 23:27-31 concerning the green tree and the dry. Study on the Candlestick; a picture of the light of the humble mind of Christ. A stature on the carnal mind of man in its hardness, doubting, reprobate mind and carnal. Three things God desires to do for our mind: (A) renew it, (B) make it lowly, (C) and give it soundness. Three aspects to the mind of God: (A) Wisdom, (B) Understanding and (C) Knowledge. 	<p>us. Proof of our loving Wisdom, His humble mind; eight places we obtain Wisdom and the stature on the Power of Wisdom. Stature on Understanding with its (A) Ministry, (B) Proof of love, (C) Place of understanding, and (D) Power of understanding.</p>	
<p><b>SP10</b></p>	<p><b>STATURE – 12<sup>th</sup> Message</b>  Candlestick continued; Stature on Knowledge: (A) Preparation of knowledge, (B) Place of Knowledge, (C) Power , and (D) Proof of Knowledge. Study on the Table of Shewbread with its three sides of Bread, Fire, and Frankincense. Stature on the Bread: (A) Presence Bread, (B) Bread of Ordering, (C) Continual Bread, and (D) Hallowed Bread. Stature of places every person will be in eternity. Fire side of the Table of Shewbread with its stature of (A) Feet, (B) Melts the cold, (C) Burns in your bones, and (D) Burns in your heart. The Frankincense side (faith) of the Table; how the Word carries faith.</p>	<p><b>Fri. am 6-28-63</b></p>
